

Medicare Prescription Payment Plan participation request form

The Medicare Prescription Payment Plan is a payment option that works with your current drug coverage to help you manage your out-of-pocket costs for drugs covered by your plan by spreading them across the calendar year (January – December). **This payment option might help you manage your expenses, but it doesn't save you money or lower your drug costs.**

This payment option **might** not be the best choice for you if you get help paying for your prescription drug costs through programs like Extra Help from Medicare or a State Pharmaceutical Assistance Program (SPAP). Call your plan for more information.

Medicare Prescription Payment Plan Billing Terms and Conditions

With the changing environment in health care, the Medicare Prescription Payment Plan was created under the Inflation Reduction Act which began January 1, 2025.

Thank you for choosing AmeriHealth Caritas VIP Care Choice (HMO-SNP) as your health plan. We are committed to the success of your treatment and care supplied by your providers. Enrolling in the Medicare Prescription Payment Plan, through AmeriHealth Caritas VIP Care Choice, provides enrollees the option to pay out-of-pocket prescription drug costs in the form of monthly payments over the course of the plan year, instead of all at once at the pharmacy. It may be a good fit if you are on a fixed budget and struggling with prescription drug costs. However, you don't need to enroll if you have a \$0 copay on all of your prescriptions.

Per the billing terms and conditions: Plan members are responsible for making the necessary payments toward covered Part D drug cost sharing you incur while in the Medicare Prescription Payment Plan program. Program participants will pay \$0 to the pharmacy for covered Part D drugs, and AmeriHealth Caritas VIP Care Choice will then bill program participants monthly for any cost sharing they incur for those medications while in the program. Pharmacies will be paid in full by AmeriHealth Caritas VIP Care Choice in accordance with Part D prompt payment requirements. Note that you are still responsible for the full cost of the pharmacy out-of-pocket cost share. The monthly payment billed by AmeriHealth Caritas VIP Care Choice is calculated to spread out the cost of your pharmacy out-of-pocket costs instead of paying them all at once at the point of purchase.

AmeriHealth Caritas VIP Care Choice is offering Plan members this opportunity to set up this payment plan for the prescriptions you will receive. This payment plan agreement authorizes AmeriHealth Caritas VIP Care Choice to bill members based on the information on file as a method to collect payment for the services provided.

Each month, AmeriHealth Caritas VIP Care Choice will send you a bill with the amount you owe for your prescriptions, when it is due, and information on how to make a payment. You will get a reminder from AmeriHealth Caritas VIP Care Choice if you miss a payment and will be

allowed a 60-day grace period to pay any past due payments.

If you do not pay your bill by the date listed in that reminder, you will first receive a *notice of failure to pay*, and if you do not pay the amount due by the time set forth in the notice you will be removed from the Medicare Prescription Payment Plan. You will have an opportunity to dispute the cancellation of your participation in the payment plan if there is a “good cause” reason for not paying your monthly bill. Call your plan if you think AmeriHealth Caritas VIP Care Choice made a mistake about your Medicare Prescription Payment Plan bill or cancellation of your Medicare Prescription Payment Plan. You will have an opportunity to file a grievance pertaining to the cancellation of your participation. The grievance process can be found in your **Evidence of Coverage**.

You are still required to pay the amount you owe, but you will not pay any interest or fees, even if your payment is late. If you are removed from the Medicare Prescription Payment Plan, you will still be enrolled in your Medicare health or drug plan.

Leaving won't affect your Medicare drug coverage and other Medicare benefits. However, keep in mind:

- If you still owe a balance to AmeriHealth Caritas VIP Care Choice on the monthly payments under the Medicare Prescription Payment Plan, you're required to pay the amount you owe, even though you are no longer participating in this payment option.
- You can choose to pay your balance all at once or be billed monthly.
- You will pay the pharmacy directly for new out-of-pocket drug costs after you leave the Medicare Prescription Payment Plan.

For payments toward your balance, you are expected to:

- Make the payments as agreed upon without default.
- Make payments until the outstanding balance in your account is zero dollars (\$0).

For your convenience, AmeriHealth Caritas VIP Care Choice offers this payment plan with no finance or interest charges. If we receive the periodic payments as set forth in this agreement, AmeriHealth Caritas VIP Care Choice shall not pursue any additional collection actions on your account. If you still owe a balance that rolls over to a new calendar year you will still be required to make that payment.

Signing the Medicare Prescription Payment Plan participation request form shall be considered binding of this Billing Terms and Conditions.
